your Bequest Gift in Will**

When creating a legacy gift in your will to the **Cancer Foundation of Saskatchewan**, it is important that you use our correct legal name: **Cancer Foundation of Saskatchewan Inc.** Using society instead of foundation can lead to your legacy going elsewhere. Please use our full legal name as:

BEQUEST SAMPLE WORDING

To pay to **Cancer Foundation of Saskatchewan Inc., Regina, SK.** (the sum of \$...or ...% of the rest, residue, remainder of my Estate) to be used for such purposes with the work that the Cancer Foundation of Saskatchewan Inc. determines is their greatest need.

Specific Direction - Alternatively, the donor may direct the use of his or her gift to a specific Cancer Centre or a strategic priority of the Cancer Foundation of Saskatchewan. Prospective donors or their professional advisors are encouraged to contact us in order to discuss current options for gift designation.

The Power to Vary clause is recommended for all directed bequests:

If, at my death, the purpose to which I have designated my gift to the Cancer Foundation of Saskatchewan Inc., Regina, SK is no longer feasible in the opinion of its Board of Directors ("the Board"), I authorize the Board to alter the purpose to a purpose that they, in their discretion, consider most closely fulfills my bequest.

TYPES OF BEQUESTS

RESIDUAL BEQUEST

After all specific bequests have been fulfilled, some or all of the remainder of your estate will be left as your legacy to the Cancer Foundation of Saskatchewan Inc.

SPECIFIC BEQUEST:

Directing a specific dollar amount or percentage of your estate to the Cancer Foundation of Saskatchewan Inc.

CONTINGENT BEQUEST:

A gift to the Cancer Foundation of Saskatchewan Inc. will be made only in the event of the death of a named beneficiary.
